

## How to get to Turning Point Taproom

### **TRAIN**

Direct trains run to Knaresborough train station from York, Harrogate, and Leeds. Knaresborough train station is then a 30 min walk, 15 min bus, or 10 min taxi from Turning Point Taproom.

### **BUS**

1A, 1B, 8 or X1 bus from Harrogate bus station to St James Retail Park, via Starbeck and Knaresborough centre.

### **TAXI**

For taxis in the Harrogate district area to our taproom, we recommend using:  
AJ's Taxis (07599 265 097)

### **WALK**

When walking from Knaresborough train station to our taproom, the quickest route is down York Road – taking approximately 30 mins.

There is, however, a more scenic route that we recommend if you have time - that is approximately 45 mins. You can follow the river Nidd by walking along Waterside and then Abbey Road, until it reaches Wetherby Road at Grimbald Bridge.

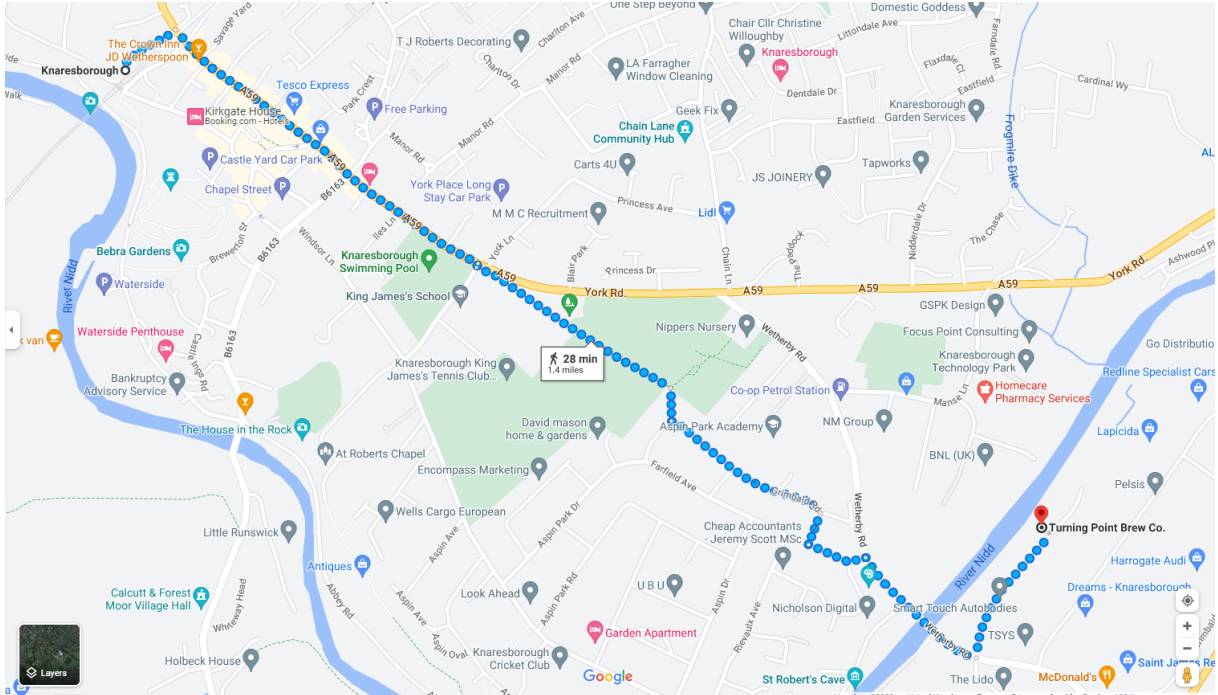
This route takes you past Knaresborough Castle, The House in the Rock, and St Robert's Cave.
